HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION**Health Effects****Acute :**

Swallowed : Do not swallow. May cause harmful central nervous system effects including headache, dizziness and drowsiness. May lead to loss of consciousness, coma, respiratory arrest and death.

First Aid

Swallowed : Do not induce vomiting. Seek medical advice.

Eye : Flush thoroughly with water for at least 15 minutes. Obtain medical attention.

Inhaled : Remove from further exposure. If unconsciousness occurs – obtain immediate medical attention and call an ambulance. If breathing has stopped, use mouth-to-mouth resuscitation.

Advice to Doctor : Treat symptoms with reference to specific health effects identified above.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

Exposure standards : There is no established TLV for this product.

Engineering Controls : Use in well ventilated area. Local exhaust ventilation maybe necessary to minimize excessive vapour if concentration levels are likely to be high.

Flammability : Flammable.

Storage and Transport : Store in a cool, ventilated position away from ignition sources and oxidizing agents. Transport in accordance with the ACTDG code for Aerosol Products.
